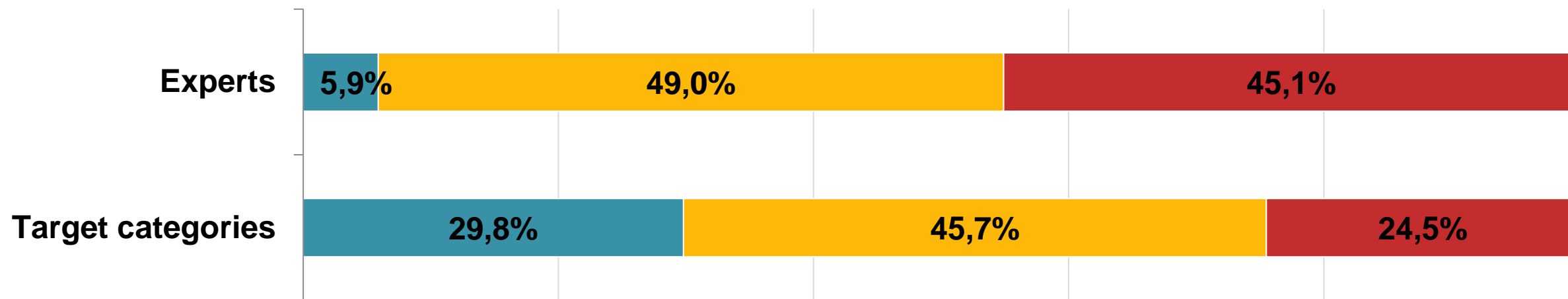

# Is Russia ready to introduce UBI?

Opinions of experts and target categories of the population



- Yes, Russia is ready to introduce UBI with a set of criteria inherent in it (full UBI)
- No, Russia is not ready, at this stage it is advisable to introduce transitional forms of UBI
- No, Russia is not ready for UBI introduction (neither full nor partial (transitional forms) UBI)

# The Results of Researches:

For **low-income families with children** - a pilot project has been carried out and a simulation model has been developed



For **young workers who graduated from educational institutions and entered the labour market for the first time** - stages of implementation of this task has been outlined



For **unemployed people** who were registered at employment centers - additional payments to unemployment benefits; a simulation model has been developed

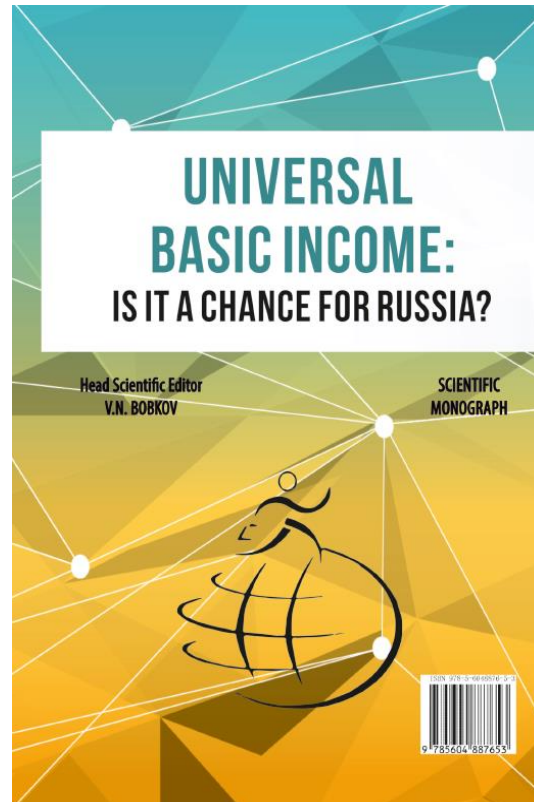


For **workers with risks of precarious employment**, especially for employees dealing with employment based on digital platforms - the stages of implementation of this task are outlined on the example of internal labor migrants
